You also have access to a team of care management clinicians who can provide extra support and guidance to help you manage your condition. If eligible, you can also access **Omada® for Diabetes**, a digital diabetes management program that delivers personalized health coaching and education to help manage diabetes at no additional cost to you. The Omada for Diabetes program includes diabetic supplies, digital tools and diabetes support.

When prescribed by a physician, HealthSelectSM participants can also get diabetic items and supplies, including glucose monitors, test strips and lancets, through the HealthSelectSM Prescription Drug Program (PDP). Brian's Journey

Brian was diagnosed with Type 2 diabetes following his annual wellness exam. His primary care provider (PCP) recommended that Brian improve his diet and get more exercise. His PCP also prescribed medication and advised him to start checking his blood sugar levels at specific times throughout the day.



Brian's diagnosis prompted him to find out how his HealthSelect of Texas medical benefits could help him manage his condition. He called the number on the back of his medical ID card and asked to speak to a clinician. The clinician shared with Brian that he had access to Omada for Diabetes, a digital diabetes condition management program available to eligible adult participants with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes.

Brian was approved for Omada and set up his online account. Within two weeks, he got a welcome kit, which included a 14-day continuous glucose monitor (CGM) and a blood glucose meter to connect to his Omada account. He also got the first of an ongoing supply of test strips and lancets.



The program provided Brian with tools and personalized support to help manage his diabetes alongside the in-person care he was getting from his doctor. He began meeting with his Omada care team who would help him on his personal path to building healthier habits.



In the weeks that followed, Brian regularly engaged with the Omada program and was able to track his progress with the data from the connected devices. Six months later, he shared his readings from the Omada app with his doctor, showing that his glucose levels had improved and were more consistently in a normal range.
