



# 1095-B TAX FORM

## What's the 1095-B form?

The 1095-B is a tax form that provides information about the employer-provided health insurance coverage you had in the previous year. You can use the form to help answer questions related to minimum essential coverage requirements of the Affordable Care Act.

## What information is on the form?

The form shows the type and dates of health coverage you and your listed dependents had in the last tax year.

## Why do I need the form?

While you are not required to include your 1095-B with your tax return, the IRS recommends that you save it for your records.

Employers are required to send the information on the 1095-B to the IRS separately.

## How do I find my 1095-B?
